

Project Summary PRISM 4 - Promoting Inclusion Services in Region 4, AM22D

The PRISM 4 - Promoting Inclusion Services in Region 4 project is implemented by IOM in partnership with ASSOC Baia Mare Association during 31.07.2024-30.07.2026. The funding is provided through the National Program 2021 – 2027 Asylum, Migration, and Integration (www.fed.mai.gov.ro) based on the non-reimbursable financing contract concluded with the Intermediate Body for Asylum, Migration, and Integration, the General Inspectorate for Immigration of the Ministry of Internal Affairs.

The objective of the project is to support the socio-economic inclusion of migrants Beneficiaries of International Protection (BIP), Third Country Nationals (TCN) and Beneficiaries of Temporary Protection (BTP) in the Romanian society. It addresses legally residing migrants from the counties of Maramureș, Satu-Mare, Sălaj, Cluj, Bistrita-Nasaud, Mureș, Harghita, Sibiu and Alba.

The project aims to:

1. Facilitate migrants' access to specific services provided by local authorities through integrated one-stop-shop services. To this end, two Regional Centers for Integration (RIC) are established in Cluj-Napoca and Baia-Mare.
2. Strengthen cooperation with the private sector and facilitate access to the labor market for migrants.
3. Encourage dialog between the host community and migrants through information campaigns and socio-cultural activities.

Project activities include:

- information and counseling services for 300 migrants
- support in obtaining permanent residence and Romanian citizenship for 50 migrants
- family reunification support for 50 migrants
- Romanian language and cultural orientation courses for 500 migrants
- socio-cultural and recreational activities for 500 migrants
- employment support services for 200 migrants
- material support for 150 vulnerable persons
- support in accessing medical services and psychological counseling for 150 migrants

- support for the purchase of supplies and other materials needed in the educational process for 100 children
- reimbursement of expenses for kindergarten, nursery or afterschool and extracurricular activities for 100 children
- information campaigns in schools, universities and the organization of various socio-cultural activities involving migrants and the local community (municipalities, educational institutions, civil society, migrant associations, etc.).
- creation of a network of intercultural mediators and volunteers to support migrants' inclusion.
